G.O.I. (Government of India) Scholarship:

The student belonging to S.C. /S.T./ V.J./ N.T./ S.B.C. &.O.B.C. categories is eligible to apply for the scheme subject to the following

Terms and Conditions:

- **I.** Annual Income of the Parents up to Rs. 200000/- for S.C. & remaining for Rs. 100000/-
- **II.** He /She should be a regular student having Good Attendance Record, Satisfactory Progress and Good Moral Conduct in the College Campus.
- **III.** He /She is responsible to submit his/her scholarship form as per the directions issued by the respective authority.

Essential Documents:

- **1.** Caste Certificate 2. Income Certificate from Revenue Officer belonging to Tahashildar's rank.
- **2.** Saving Account in any Nationalized Bank. 4. Adhar Card 5. Gap Certificate 6. E-mail. Id (Only for the students with a break in Studies)

Minority Scholarship:

- The Student belonging to Muslim, Buddhist, Jain, Sikh, Parsi and Christian is qualified to apply for the scheme.

Terms and Conditions:

- **I.** He/ She should secure minimum 50% marks in the Previous Examination.
- **II.** The annual Income of the family should not exceed Rs. 200000/-.

Rajashree Shahu Maharaj Scholarship (Only for the students those who secured 75 % and above marks in std. 12th Examinations) :

- The students belonging to S.C./ V.J./ N.T./ and S.B.C. categories are qualified to apply for the scheme.

Terms and Conditions:

- **I.** He/ She should secure minimum 75% marks in the Previous Examinations.

- **II.** He/ She should submit the Income Certificate of the family.

Scholarship for Physically Handicapped Students:

- The student who is Physically Handicapped is qualified to apply for the scheme.
- He must submit his application along with the Certificate from the District Civil Surgeon.

E. B. C. (Economically Backward Classes) Concession:

- The student who is economically backward (annual family income less than Rs. 2, 50,000/-) can apply for the concession.
- **Note:** The student must submit the Ration Card along with the application. (Only two children of the family can avail the Concession.)

Free ship Concession:

- The student belonging to S.T. / V.J. / N.T. /OBC/ S.B.C. categories can apply for the concession (The annual income of the family is limited to Rs. 600000 /-) & No limit for S.C.
- **Note:** Application forms for EBC and other concessions are available on the website. The online application must be submitted and the hard copy of the same along with all the documents should be submitted to the College on or before due date set by the college.

Note:

- **I.** *The student who is qualified for more than one of the above mentioned schemes can apply only for one.*
- **II.** *Scholarships will be paid as per the Government norms.*
- **III.** *In case of rejection of the application form by the concerning authority, the college will not be responsible for the same.*
- **IV.** *The student should update the related information from time to time by consulting the concerning College authority.*
- **V.** *Refundable fees and other fees not reimbursed by the Government will have to be paid by the student.*

University Scholarship (Students Welfare Fund):

The students of B. A. I, B. Sc. I, B. Com. I, M. Sc. I (Annual Income limit Rs. 50000/- and 50% marks in the Previous Examination) can apply for the scheme.

For B.A.I, B.Sc.-I, B.Com.-I: - Rs. 1000/- , M.Sc.-I: - Rs.1500/-

University is a final authority to sanction the scholarship and is not bound to sanction it to every applicant.
