





INTRODUCTION

Plants have been used by humans even before we come to be Homo sapiens because we are omnivores plants have been an important part of our diet. for a long time, as well as the diet of our ancestors.

History of Botany

Botany appears to have had originated as far back as the Stone Age. Early man's interest may have been simply to learn what different herbs & plants could be used as food. This could be seen as an early & basic form of plant classification, grouping them as edible & inedible Written manuals for the use of herbs in medicine existed as far back as 3000 BC in Mesopotamia & China while. The Egyptians also wrote much on the medicinal uses of plants the study of botany, the earliest written botanical information that we possess today came from the Greeks.

The term 'botany' itself probably come from the Greek words botanikos (botanical) and botane (plant or herb) The Greek philosopher Aristotle collected information about plants but it was really his student Theophrastus [371-286 B.C]. who inherited his teacher's library & began to devise more complex systems of plant classification he is sometimes to referred to as the "Father of Botany".

Plants were exchanged & studied in early cultures, but it wasn't until Columbus began his voyages in 1492 that we have record of the interchange of plants between the Eastern & western Hemisphere. Columbus left spain to search for new routes & Sources for importing spices from the East. He returned from his voyages with corn and other crop plants. In 1603 Adrian van de spiegel (1578-1625) published instructions on producing dried herbarium, specimens in isagoges in Rem Herbarium. Linnaeus, who is often called the father of Taxonomy was first botonists to embrace the practice of extensive travel for fieldwork. It is reported that between 1745 and 1792 nineteen of Linnaeus's students went of to distant lands to collect new plant specimens.

The variety of life on Earth & its biological diversity is commonly reffered to as biodiversity. The number of species of plants, animals & microorganisms, the enormous diversity of genus in these species; the different ecosystems on the planet such as deserts, rainforests and coral reefs are all part of a biologically diverse Earth. Biological diversity

REVIEW OF LITERATURE

- Tectona grandis, Mangifera indica, Azadiracta indica, Melia dubia species are mainly preferred by Farmers due to its timber value, fast growing nature, multiple uses & their better performance in Bharangi village. These results are similar to the study conducted by Hanumantha et al. (2018). They documented timber species utilization pattern in siddapur taluk of Karnataka & reported Artocarpus heterophyllus, Colophyllum apetalum & Acacia auriculiformis are the major species used by local people and falling under families of Clusiaceae, Combretaceae and Mimosaceae [Kumar., et al (2016)].
- Harish kumar & kiran (2016) during their survey and documentation reported 27 timber yielding species falling under 13 families in Bhadravathi taluka, karnataka. Major timber yielding species recorded were Acacia auriculiformis, Azadiracta indica, Pongamia pinnata and Tectona grandis. In this study, maximum number of formers preferred Tectona grandis (80.0%) followed by Mangifera indica (63.33%) and Azadiracta indica (60%) Melia dubia (50.0%) on their forms lands and léast preferred are Albizia odorattisima (10%) and sapindus mukorossi (10%) Tectona grandis and Melia dubia is mainly preferred due to its fast growing nature good timber properties and market price; whereas mango and neem are grown for multiple uses such as fruits, shade, timber since olden days. Thees results are similar with the study conducted by Shivanna et al. (2005). They reported 31 to 39% of the farmers in Gadag district prefer Azadiracta indica on their farm use and followed by Acacia nilotica.
- Among the 35 timber yielding species, maximum number of species (25) were utilized for agricultural implements and fuel wood followed by house construction (23) furniture (10) and least for ply wood and decorative articles (4). Majority of the timber species are used for more than three purposes except Sapindus mukorossi, Pongamia pinnata, Areca catechu, Cocos nucifera, Gliricidia sepium and Cordia myxa because of its other uses. A Similar study of documentation of traditional wood consumption pattern in Anoacha, Nigeria was done by [Emeka.,et al (2016)].

MATERIAL AND METHODS

In India Digras taluka is in Yavatmal District of Maharashtra state in the vast area of 11.5 sq. km of Digras. A large number and variety of Timber Yielding Plant's studied during the academic session 2023-24. The study of timber yielding trees species for during the academic session 2023-24 to April 2024, Field visit where conducted project were studied during August 2023 to April 2024, Field visit where conducted project were studied during August 2023 to april 2024, Field visit where conducted during this session and at that time I collected onsite some photographs of habit, flowering during this session and at that time I collected onsite some photographs of habit, flowering and bark of trees. During the visit number of elderly person of tribal community were contracted and information was collected through interview, discussion and observation held at the time of study. The discussion reveled local name of plant species, plant part use and formation of herbal colours used by rural communities. The species were scientifically identify with their botanical names and author index. The identified record plant were further varified with Flora of Presidency of Bombay by T. cooke Vol. 1 & III, Flora of Maharashtra state (BSI) Vol. I & II by N.P Singh and S. Karthikeyan, Flora of Yavatmal district (BSI) by S. karthikeyan and Anand kumar & Experts of Department of Botany, B. B. Arts N.B. Commerce and B.P. Science College, Digras.

The study of Timber Yielding Plants were conducted in and around Digras tahsil, from area such as phetri forest and singad forest. A number of group discussions were also conducted during the study period. As a result of field visit, it was possible to collect most of the plants in vegetative, flowering and fruiting stage. In course of visit observations were enter in a note book. The habit, habitat, types of soil, flower colors, fruits and seeds, character of bark, any economic and local uses etc were recorded. For convenience, Bentham and Hookers System of Classification is followed in the present work and families are arranged accordingly. The genera in each family and the specimens in each genus were arranged in alphabetical sequence for the convenience of reference for easy identification etc.


Polyalthia longifolia (sonn.) Thw.

RESULT

Wood is one of the prime sources of forest products and it has been consistently used around. The globe for the thousands of years. The society has possessed good knowledge of furniture, house construction etc. However, their high exploitation & continues exposure to modernization may results in extinction of the plants in the forest or outside forest. Diversity of trees mostly used timber species e.q. Tectona grandis, Mangifera indica.

Timber is dominant constituent of forests which is considered as the most important and valuable forest resources. It has immense importance to the living organism & to derive the nation's economy. It played an important role in the economy of state and is an asset to the country. Timber is an important source of raw materials of various industries and provides much needed wood, fuel, paper, rayon, softwood, tannin, qums, resins and wax. [Premavani et.al (2014)]. Moreover, tribe communities and the villagers use timber for various purposes i.e agricultural implements.

In Digras Tahsil many types of trees are found which play an important role in our life. They found on Playground, Campus of schools, Colleges, Parks etc. The most of primary needs of human beings are fulfilled by the trees. The trees species have medicinal importance, use in furniture & also have great value. They provide food, shelter, medicine & tools. Various types of trees found in & around Digras Tahsil such as Timber Yielding Trees-Babul, Mango. Medicinal trees such as Neem etc. From the pre-historic time they are use by quality of air & decrease the pollution of the area. These timber three species contribute to the shaping & microbial communities.

During the project work, 30 plant species were studied which are belonging to 15 families. Fabaceae have (10) plant species, Rutaceae (4), Myrtaceae (2), Moraceae (2), Verbenaceae (2) all remaining families have single member like Annonaceae, Anacardiaceae, Combretaceae, Bignoniaceae, Apocynaceae, Meliaceae, Bombecaceae, Sapotaceae, Simaroubaceae, Rhamnaceae. The timbers of Tectona grandis (Verbenaceae) have a very high quality. All the studied plant species are trees having great value of timber, which are used for many household properties for making toys, construction materials.
