

Subject : Scheme for Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Awarding Grades to the Post Graduate Students in the Faculty of Science, Direction, 2010.

Date : 24/06/2010

Whereas, University Grants Commission, New Delhi vide D.O.No.F-2/2008/(XI Plan), Dtd.31 Jan.2008 regarding new initiatives under the 11th Plan - Academic Reforms in the University has suggested for improving quality of higher education and to initiate the Academic Reform at the earliest.

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council while considering the above letter in its meeting held on 30.4.2008, vide item No.55 has resolved to refer the same to Dean's Committee, and the Dean's Committee in its meeting held on 19.07.2008 has decided to refer the matter to all Board of Studies.

AND

Whereas, the recommendations of various Board of Studies in the faculty of Science regarding Upgradation and Revision of various syllabi and introduction of choice based credit pattern Examination System at post graduate level was considered by the faculty of Science in its meeting held on 7.12.2009 and constituted a Committee of all Chairmen of Board of Studies and one member nominated by Chairmen of respective B.O.S. under the Chairmanship of Dean of faculty to decide the policy decision regarding choice based credit system examination pattern at P.G. level.

AND

Whereas, the faculty of Science in its emergent meeting held on 11th May, 2010 vide item No.27, has considered, accepted and recommended to Academic Council, the policy decision regarding introduction of Scheme for Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Awarding Grades to the Post Graduate Students in the Faculty of Science under ordinance No.4 of 2008. The recommendations of the faculty was approved by the Academic Council in its emergent meeting held on 28.5.2010, vide item No.36.

AND

Whereas, Ordinance No.4 of 2008 in respect of Examinations leading to the Degree of B.A. (Bachelor of Science) is in existence in the University as per semester pattern examination system.

Whereas, it is necessary to frame the Regulation regarding the Scheme for Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Awarding Grades to the Post Graduate Students in the Faculty of Science which is to be implemented from the Academic Session 2010-11 of M.Sc. Semester-I & onwards to all subjects in the faculty of Science and framing of Regulation for the above examination is likely to take some time.

AND

Whereas, the admission of students in the above pattern at M.Sc. Part-I (Semester-I) of all subjects in the faculty of Science are to be made in the Academic Session 2010-11.

Now, therefore, I, Dr. Kamal Singh, Vice Chancellor of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, in exercise of powers conferred upon me under sub-section (8) of section 14 of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994, do hereby direct as under:

1. This Direction may be called "Scheme for Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Awarding Grades to the Post Graduate Students in the Faculty of Science, 2010-11".
2. This Direction shall come into force with effect from the examination as shown below for all subjects for the Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Science in the faculty of Science-
 - (i) Winter 2010 examination for M.Sc. Part-I, Semester-I,
 - (ii) Summer-2011 examination for M.Sc. Part-I, Semester-II,
 - (iii) Winter-2011 examination for M.Sc. Part-II, Semester-III,
 - (iv) Summer-2012 examination for M.Sc. Part-II, Semester-IV.
3. The detailed Scheme for Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Awarding Grades to the Post Graduate students in the Faculty of Science is as given below-

I. The CBCS System

All Programmes (named after the Core subject) mentioned in para 9 of Ordinance No.4 of 2008 shall be run on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and the grades in 7 point scale will be awarded to the students. It is an instructional package developed to suit the needs of students to keep pace with the developments in higher education and the quality assurance expected of it in the light of liberalization and globalization in higher education.

II. Credits and Degrees

- i) A candidate who has successfully completed all the core courses Compulsory, Elective/ Specialised courses and project prescribed and optional approved by the University for the programme

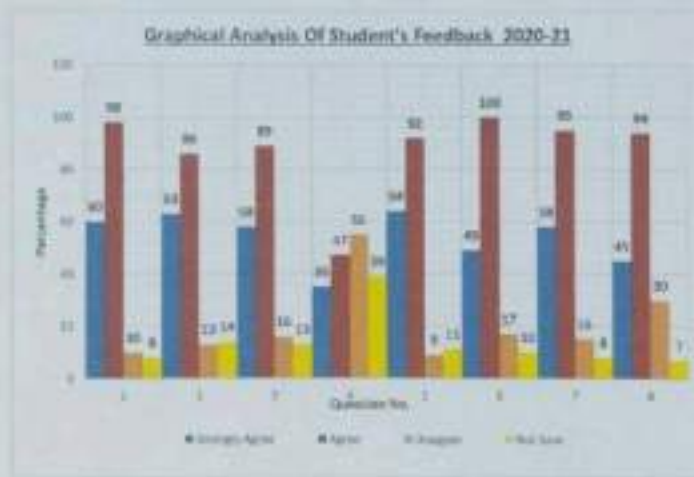

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INDIA-RUSSIA PARTNERSHIP

IN THE FAST-CHANGING GLOBAL ORDER

Russian President Vladimir Putin was on a brief working visit to New Delhi on 8 December to take part in the 21st India-Russia Annual Summit with Prime Minister Narendra Modi. This was President Putin's only second visit out of Russia since March 2020. The only other visit he had undertaken during the same period was a brief visit to Geneva for the Russia-US Summit with President Joe Biden.

"The fact that President Putin has decided to visit India for our annual summit exceptionally is an indication of the importance he attaches to the bilateral relationship," Haresh Vaidhan Shringla, India's Foreign Secretary, underlined, mentioning President Putin had conferred Russia's highest civilian award, the Order of St. Andrew the Apostle, on Prime Minister Modi in 2016. Last year, the annual Summit was not held because of the COVID pandemic.

The visit concluded in a joint statement, titled 'India-Russia Partnership for Peace, Progress, and



Prosperity'. Putin called India a 'great power, a friendly nation, and a time-tested friend.' Indian PM Modi stated that the India-Russia friendship had remained a constant amid all the geopolitical changes in the global arena in the past decades.

In the 89-point joint statement issued after the Summit, India and Russia agreed to intensify consultations on complementarities between integration and development initiatives in greater

Eurasian space and in the regions of India and Pacific Oceans. The joint statement, capturing the state and future potential of bilateral ties, mentioned signing a record number of 38 agreements or Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs). These agreements were both government to government and business to business covering various sectors including trade, energy, culture, intellectual property, accountability, cyber-attacks in the banking

sector, workforce, geological exploration, survey, education, etc.

The two countries renewed the military-technical cooperation deal for 2021-31. Also, they signed an agreement for the joint production of 601,427 AK-203 assault rifles at a manufacturing facility in Uttar Pradesh's Amethi during the 20th meeting of the India-Russia Inter-Governmental Commission on Military and Military-Technical Cooperation (RIOC-MAMTC). "Given a large number of platform holdings of Russian equipment with Indian armed forces, the extension of the 10-year agreement was inevitable. This is a major signal to Washington that despite CAATSA (Countering America's Adversaries Through Sanctions Act) enacted in the background, India is not likely to curb back imports of Russian defence equipment in the near or mid-term." Brigadier Rahul Sharma (Retired), a Delhi-based security analyst, assessed. CAATSA is a US law passed in 2017 to prevent countries

CIVIL SERVICES (MAIN) EXAM

DECODING GENERAL STUDIES-II & GENERAL STUDIES-III

The real challenge of the Civil Services (Main) examination lies in mastering the huge General Studies (GS) syllabus comprising four papers carrying 250 marks each. Together, the weight of GS is the exam is higher than the optional paper and the essay paper. Needless to say, then, that it is hard to imagine success in the civil services exam without a good command over all GS papers. This is not to downplay the role of the optional and the essay papers but to stress the imperative of giving sufficient time to prepare for the entire GS syllabus. All four GS papers are multidisciplinary in other words, each paper is a mix of different disciplines. For example, GS Paper-I is composed of history, art, culture, and society. GS Paper-II comprises Indian polity, governance and administrative



issues, schemes, programs, and government policies in social sectors like health, education, the welfare of weaker sections, and their impact. It also includes international relations. GS Paper-III combines four disciplines: economy, disaster management, science and technology, and internal security. Finally, GS Paper-IV deals with ethics, social psychology, philosophical aspects of administration, and case studies. Questions are set on all syllabus areas necessitating the

study of each section of the prescribed syllabus. At the same time, all disciplines within a single GS paper do not carry equal weight in terms of the number of questions. To cite an example, in GS Paper-II, polity and governance carry more weight than international relations. Therefore, one has to give emphasis to topics according to their proportionate weight.

GS PAPER-II

Of all the four GS papers, Paper-II is the most interesting, very dynamic, and contemporary. Comprising sections on polity, governance, and international relations, it arouses the keen interest of aspirants because the topics relate to contemporary issues reported in newspapers and journals almost every day. It does not, however, mean that there are no static portions in GS-II. For example, there shall always be questions from the structural aspects of the Constitution, eg. parliament, executive, federalism, etc. However, even these static aspects will be linked with contemporary issues. The same can be said about international
